Cones or other items will be used to mark off these areas. Children will be advised on how to hold the Yabbies and not to antagonise the animals. Any child not listening to the rules will not hold a Yabby. If a child is bitten, a Fish Finders staff will assist them and Educators with first aid. First Aid kids will be at the activity area supplied by the centre. Fish Finders staff will demonstrate how to care for a Yabby and how they are to be properly handled. Fish Finders staff will pick up all Yabbies at the commencement and ending of activity. 	Educators/Children/Fish Finders Staff	On Shift – At Centre

Rod Control & Safe Casting Clinic Activity	Moderate	 An outdoor area with ample room and visibility will be chosen, such as the oval. Children will be spaced out when casting the rods and will go one at a time under the instruction of the Fish Finders staff. Fish Finders staff will go through with the children a 10 Step Casting program to ensure the proper use of a rod. Areas will be coned to show where the casting will take place and any children not partaking or finished their turn will be kept behind these designated areas to avoid injury from any casting rods. Rods and other equipment will be checked by Fish Finders staff before use (and Educators) to ensure no equipment is faulty.
