Each equipment use has a set limit of children to use at one time to minimise injury (groupings/numbers to be determined on day based on location of activity). Blast Off staff to do prior check with centre to ensure equipment is age appropriate and accessible to all children. Children will be reminded to walk from centre to activity on the school grounds and to watch where they are walking.
