Educators will position themselves at the beginning of the line, the end of the line and evenly down the middle of the line for the walk to the venue. The Educator in the middle of the group will take over from the lead Educator in the middle of the road as the children cross, allowing the lead Educator to continue with the front of the group. Where a staff member leaving in an ambulance then compromises our child to staff ratio, and the activity is deemed unsafe with the number of remaining educators, the children will immediately be returned to the centre | Educators | During excursion | Low |

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| General - Walking to and from venue | Bottles, rubbish, dangerous items on road/footpath | Extreme | One educators is to walk ahead of children to do a thorough inspection of the environment prior to children walking through.. Educators are to remove any rubbish from the area if safe to do so. If there are any dangerous items which cannot be moved then educators should use an alternate route to walk. | Educators | During excursion | Low |
| Walking to and from Venue Walking to and from Venue | Sun Burn, Heatstroke, dehydration, Extreme hot weather etc. | Extreme | Should the temperature become too hot to return to OOSH by foot, alternative arrangements will be made to ensure the safety of each child. Parents will be contacted and notified immediately should there be changes to the daily programs travel arrangements / pickup location. | Educators | Temperature to be assessed prior to leaving on excursion for a decision / alternate plans to be made | Low |
| General/Brickpit Courts | Child Protection | High | Children will never be left alone with members of the public without supervision. All Educators hold WWCC as do venue staff. | Educators | During Excursion | Low |

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| Brickpit Courts | Injury (General) Sprains, strains, broken bones, dislocation) | High | Children will be advised prior to commencement of and during excursion to play with caution and to keep a safe distance from peers. Brickpit staff to ensure facility is safe for use and free from hazard. Brickpit staff and NWOOSH educators first aid trained. Where a child has a serious injury, one staff member will render first aid, whilst the others move the other children away and ensure adequate supervision. Where an ambulance is required to be called, the staff member will notify the RPD, and the venue staff who will assist in calling the ambulance. Where a staff member leaving in an ambulance then compromises our child to staff ratio, and the activity is deemed unsafe with the number of remaining educators, the children will immediately be returned to the centre. | Educators, Children and Brickpit staff | Before and during Excursion | Low |
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| Brickpit Courts | Injury from sporting equipment/ | High | Children will be reminded to keep a safe distance from each other while using equipment. Children will be reminded to be cautious of their surroundings while using equipment. Where a child has a serious injury, one staff member will render first aid, whilst the others move the other children away and ensure adequate supervision. Where an ambulance is required to be called, the staff member will notify the RPD, and the venue staff who will assist in calling the ambulance. Where a staff member leaving in an ambulance then compromises our child to staff ratio, and the activity is deemed unsafe with the number of remaining educators, the children will immediately be returned to the centre. | Educators/Children | During excursion, prior to use of equipment | Low |
| Brickpit Courts | Injury from falling fixtures (lighting, signage) | High | Children will be reminded to use equipment with caution and to keep a safe distance between equipment and lighting. Where a child has a serious injury, one staff member will render first aid, whilst the others move the other children away and ensure adequate supervision. Where an ambulance is required to be called, the staff member will notify the RPD, and the venue staff who will assist in calling the ambulance. Where a staff member leaving in an ambulance then compromises our child to staff ratio, and the activity is deemed unsafe with the number of remaining educators, the children will immediately be returned to the centre. | Educators/Children | During excursion, prior to use of equipment | Low |

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| Brickpit Courts | Injury from falls/ slips due to water (Showers and taps in bathrooms and changerooms) | High | Brickpit staff to inspect changerrooms prior to excursion and If water discovered on tiles to notify supervisor on duty immediately who will eliminate with towel and erect warning signs. Educators will inspect bathrooms and changerrooms before the commencement of the excursion to ensure there are no water hazards due to shower or taps. Children will be reminded not to enter shower area or turn on shower taps. Children will be reminded to turn off all taps after use and to dry floors with paper towel should any water splash on to the ground. Educators to inspect bathrooms following use by the children. Where a child has a serious injury, one staff member will render first aid, whilst the others move the other children away and ensure adequate supervision. Where an ambulance is required to be called, the staff member will notify the RPD, and the venue staff who will assist in calling the ambulance. Where a staff member leaving in an ambulance then compromises our child to staff ratio, and the activity is deemed unsafe with the number of remaining educators, the children will immediately be returned to the centre. | Educators/Children/Brickpit Staff | Before, During and After Excursion | Low |
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| Brickpit Courts | Injury from falls/ slips due to water (bubblers) | High | Brickpit staff to ensure signage next to bubbler notifying patron's not to leave bubbler on & to fill bottles over sink to reduce spillage. If water on floor discovered, supervisor to mop up immediately & leave out wet floor signage. Children will be reminded to be cautious of where they are walking. Where a child has a serious injury, one staff member will render first aid, whilst the others move the other children away and ensure adequate supervision. Where an ambulance is required to be called, the staff member will notify the RPD, and the venue staff who will assist in calling the ambulance. Where a staff member leaving in an ambulance then compromises our child to staff ratio, and the activity is deemed unsafe with the number of remaining educators, the children will immediately be returned to the centre. | Educators/Children/Brickpit Staff | During Excursion | Low |
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| Brickpit Courts (Grandstand and Mezzanine) | Injury from trips/falls down stairs | High | Brickpit staff to ensure all stairs are free of hazards. Educators to remind children to walk down stairs and not run. Educators to remind children to use hand rails provided by Brickpit Facility. One educator to supervise grandstand and mezzanine at all times reminding children to walk. Brickpit staff to ensure hand rails are in adequate condition. Where a child has a serious injury, one staff member will render first aid, whilst the others move the other children away and ensure adequate supervision. Where an ambulance is required to be called, the staff member will notify the RPD, and the venue staff who will assist in calling the ambulance. Where a staff member leaving in an ambulance then compromises our child to staff ratio, and the activity is deemed unsafe with the number of remaining educators, the children will immediately be returned to the centre. | Educators/Children/Brickpit Staff | Before and During Excursion | Low |
| | Injury from activities conducted in other courts | Medium | Brickpit Staff will have set up the moveable divider to minimise risk of balls crossing the courts and being stopped by the divider. If this is not set up upon arrival, RPD will advise Stadium Manager to erect the divider. | Educators/Children/Brickpit Staff | Before and During Excursion | Low |
| COVID-19 | Infection & Prevention Procedures | High | Brickpit Stadium is a COVID Safe Venue. The venue is limited to maximum 300 capacity to which the Stadium Manager will advise upon arrival if entry can be allowed due to capacity restraints. | Educators/Children/Brickpit Staff | Before and During Excursion | Low |

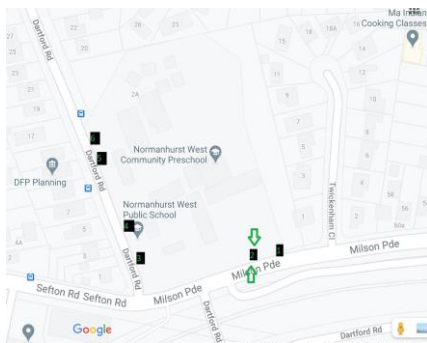
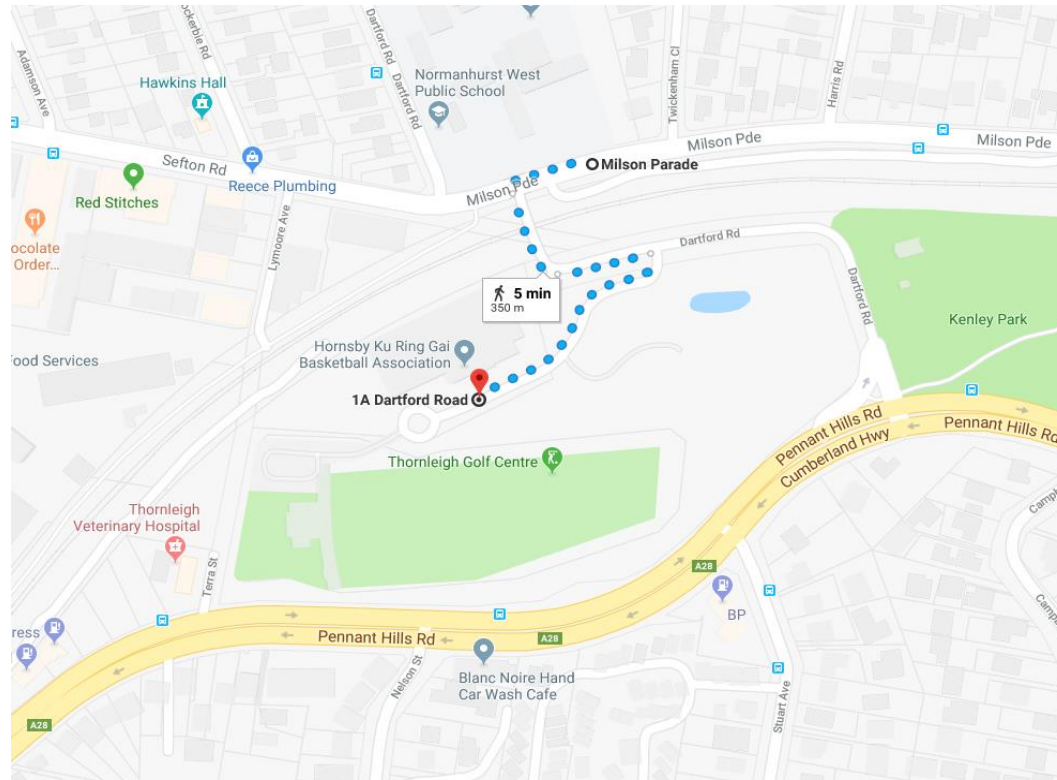
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| COVID-19 | Infection & Prevention Procedures | High | Equipment used by NWOOSH will be cleaned prior to arrival with only the NWOOSH group having access to this set equipment. This equipment includes volleyball/badminton nets and the basketball hoops. NWOOSH will bring their own basketball and other equipment as required, which educators will clean prior to and after use at the venue. | Educators/Children/Brickpit Staff | Before and During Excursion | Low |
| COVID-19 | Infection & Prevention Procedures | High | Parents will be advised before excursion to ensure children have a packed water bottle. Staff to ensure all water bottles are filled and taken on the excursion. The children will be reminded by staff the public water fountains are out of bounds and not to be used. | Educators/Children/Parents | Before and During Excursion | Low |
| COVID-19 | Infection & Prevention Procedures | High | Children will be reminded about the above procedures and include the designated arrow walkway in areas around the stadium that have to be adhered to. Barriers are also in place in some areas to guide flow of people. | Educators/Children/Brickpit Staff | Before and During Excursion | Low |
| Transportation Method | Seat Belt Requirements & Entry/Exit Information | Low | As this excursion is being conducted with the mode of transport as Walking/By Foot, the Transport-Seat Belt requirements do not apply to this excursion. Entry/Exit of Premises will be via School Gate 2 and to the Venue via front doors adjacent to carpark. | Educators | During Excursion | Low |

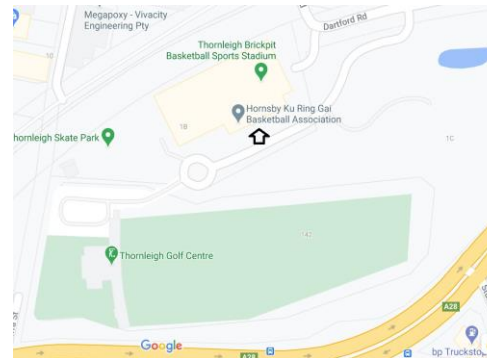
