Children will put their hats on before leaving the OOSH building. Children without a hat will be given one from the Centre. • Children will be checked for drink bottles and asked to ensure all are filled prior to the activity. • Children will be given regular drink breaks throughout the day to ensure they remain hydrated. • Sunscreen will be applied to each child, where permission has been given & UV 3 or above. Serious Injury to a Child	Moderate	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Where a child has a serious injury, one staff member will render first aid, whilst the others move the other children away and ensure adequate supervision. Where an ambulance is required to be called, the staff member will notify the RPD, who will assist in calling the ambulance. Where a staff member leaving in an ambulance then compromises our child to staff ratio, and the activity is deemed unsafe with the number of remaining educators, the children will immediately be returned to the main room. <p>Go – Kart (General) - Use of Karts</p>	<p>High</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Children will be Briefed prior to use about safety precautions & Rules to adhere to throughout the activity. • Children are to remain in Designated groups – Directed by Staff • Be sure to clearly state expectation of not changing from your small group activity. • Go Karts only go 2km/h & Operator equipped with Kart Remote control. • Students are individually instructed on Kart Operation • Seat Belts will be worn at all times when using Karts. • Children who are not following instructions will be removed from activity and remain with a NWOOSH Staff member. 	<p>Go- Kart Staff/Educators/Children</p>	<p>On Shift – At Centre</p>
<p>Transmission of COVID-19</p>	<p>High</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Educators and Go kart staff to ensure staff members displaying COVID-19 symptoms are removed from activity and sent home as soon as possible. • Children who are displaying COVID-19 symptoms or are unwell will be removed from participating in the activity and parents will be phoned and advised to collect their child • All educators, visitors, volunteers and Go Kart staff will sign in to the NWOOSH premises and sanitise, have their temperatures taken and questionnaire answered prior to the commencement of the activity • Go Kart staff will ensure all equipment including Go-Karts/Equipment Needed for the day will be sanitised prior to entering the premise.
