GET READY FOR VACATION CARE

NWOSHC BEHAVIOURAL AGREEMENT

The acceptance of our behavioural agreement is a vital part of our centre's enrolment process.

At Normanhurst West OSHC, we aim to ensure that the Centre (whether we are on or off site) is a safe and happy environment for all children, staff and families. It is essential that all the children and parents are aware that there are rules to ensure the safety and happiness of all at OSHC. It is necessary to make clear that these rules have consequences should they be broken.

The rules that concern Normanhurst West OSHC are stated as follows:

Each child must:

- Behave in a safe and courteous manner towards others using the centre, including staff & other children.
- Treat others as he/she would like to be treated.
- Always play in sight of a member of staff and away from designated out of bounds areas boundaries are marked by boundary cones.
- Follow any directions given by a staff member.
- Use appropriate language and manners at all times.
- · Not physically harm others.
- Assist with cleaning up and putting away equipment when requested & respecting equipment at all times.
- Ensure electronic games and mobile phones are not used in the centre unless otherwise stated (e.g. as
 part of a programmed activity) and are left in the OSHC office to minimise loss or damage to property.

Where a child breaks the centre rules, the following procedure will be followed.

- 1. A gentle, verbal reminder of the rule/s being broken and if appropriate a re-direction to another activity.
- 2. A direct request for the child to stop, advising which rule has been broken.
- 3. Reflection time- including a verbal mention of misbehaviour to parents/guardians at end of the OSHC session, or earlier if applicable.
- 4. Where incidents are continual or of concern, written notification to parents requesting a meeting to create a plan of action, indicating relevant incident/s, warning of the risk of suspension and advising of school notification.
- 5. In the event of consistent unacceptable behaviour, or physically injuring or threatening injury to other children and/or adults at the centre, temporary suspension may be enforced immediately, decided by the Management Committee.
- 6. Suspension of a child for 3 booked sessions or agreed upon timeline with Management Committee.
- 7. Further breaches of the rules OR physical actions may result in long term suspension until proof of change in behaviour is received.
